Basic Skills Trailer Bill Update

Additional \$30m in On-going Funds

- For 2016-17:
 - Fund Transformation Grant Applications that were eligible but not funded (additional 21 colleges)
 - Use remaining funds for professional development

Basic Skills Trailer Bill Update

Additional \$30m in On-going Funds

- Chancellor's Office develops new allocation formula for BSI to implement for 2017-18 funds
 - 50% on performance metrics
 - 25% on low-income students,
 - 25% on FTES in evidence-based basic skills practices

BSI Allocation for 2016-17

From the \$19m On-Going

- Details are not yet available
- Two possibilities:
 - Use the current formula
 - Funding is equivalent to 2015-16 allocation

The State of the BSI: Stronger than Ever

- Transformations on Colleges
- Professional Development: 3CSN
- Funding
 - \$19m Ongoing
 - \$60m Transformation Grant
 - \$10m Partnership Grant
 - \$30m Additional Ongoing
- →Over \$100m into Basic Skills!

The Flip Side

- 21 Colleges not eligible for funding
- 28 Colleges did not apply
- Initiative fatigue
- Competing for funds
- Performance based funding
- Noncredit Basic Skills

Transformation Grant Summit

- August 2-3 in Sacramento, Doubletree Hotel
- Funded Colleges to send teams
- Goals:
 - Connect with colleges implementing similar practices
 - Connect with groups specializing in those practices
 - Develop first (or next) steps for implementing proposals
 - Review reporting requirements for grant
