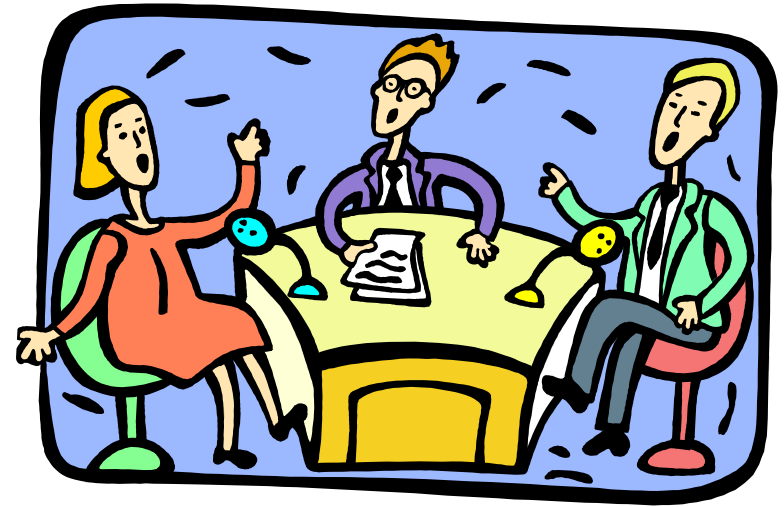

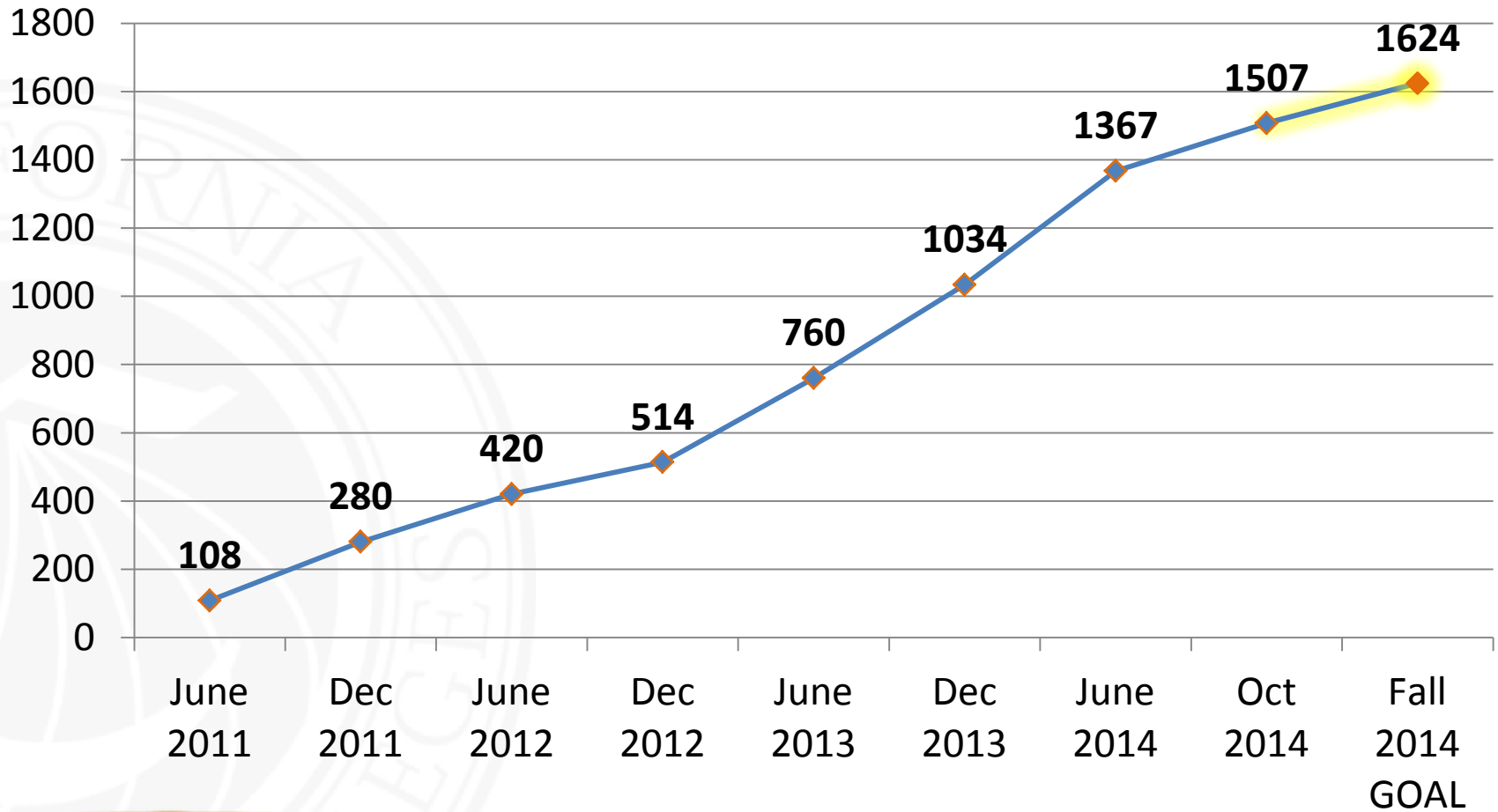


# A Moment to Celebrate

- Implementation of C-IDs
  - Common Course Numbering Legislation from 2004
- Will reach 100% goal set by colleges
  - December 2014

- Taskforce or Blue Ribbon Committee
- Public Hearings
- Report with recommendations
- Legislation written and passed
- Statute (California Education Code)
- Regulations (Title 5)
- Program & Course Approval Handbook





# AB 1725 (1988-1989)

- Shared Governance
- Minimum Faculty Qualifications
- 75:25 Full Time/Part Time faculty
- Faculty Curriculum Committees
- Faculty participation in hiring and peer review
- Non-Credit programs
- Transfer/CTE/Basic Skills

- Veterans Prior Learning Assessment (2015)



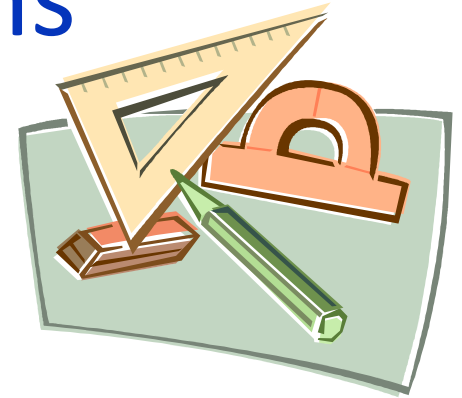

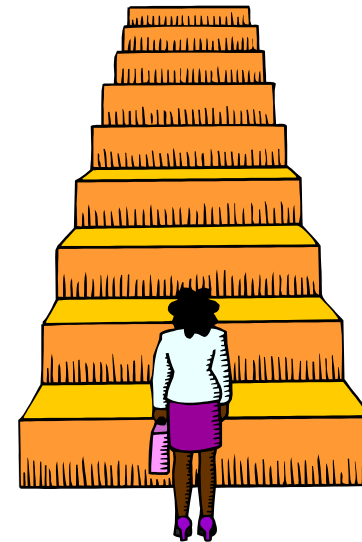
