ISSUE: This item will include a presentation and discussion related to the variety of ways the Foundation for California Community Colleges (Foundation) works to provide direct support and savings to colleges throughout the California community college system.

BACKGROUND: This presentation was recently debuted in collaboration with the Community College League of California at the California Community College Northern California CEO Conference as part of an ongoing effort by the Foundation to raise awareness throughout the system of cost-savings, efficiency measures, and statewide partnerships and programs that are currently in place and available for all California Community Colleges.
