ISSUE: This item will include a presentation and discussion related to the variety of ways the Foundation for California Community Colleges (Foundation) works to provide direct support and savings to students, colleges, college foundations and the system.

BACKGROUND: This presentation provides current information related to key Foundation programs and services designed to create cost-savings, efficiency measures, and statewide partnerships and programs in place and available to support the mission of the California Community Colleges.
