ISSUE: This item provides to the Board the recommended selection of California Community Colleges for the Baccalaureate Degree Pilot Program.

RECOMMENDATION: This item is presented to the Board to take action on the Baccalaureate Degree Pilot College Application Recommendations.

BACKGROUND: On September 28, 2014, California Governor Jerry Brown signed SB 850 (Block) authorizing the Board of Governors of the California Community Colleges (BOG), in consultation with representatives of the California State University (CSU) and University of California (UC), to establish a statewide Baccalaureate Degree Pilot Program at no more than 15 California Community Colleges. The Board of Governors was charged to develop a process for selection of the pilot programs.

On November 21, 2014, the Academic Affairs Division released the Baccalaureate Degree Pilot Program Application. The deadline to submit an application to participate was December 19, 2014. The selected readers were statewide representatives from community college districts, the CSU and UC systems and the California Department of Education.
