On behalf of the California Community Colleges Student Mental Health Program (CCC SMHP) I am pleased to announce the recipients of Campus Based Grants (CBG) component funding. This Notice of Intent to Award is subject to the execution of a written contract and does not constitute the formation of a contract between the CCC SMHP and the colleges or consortia listed above. In the next few days, these applicants will be contacted by CCC SMHP staff to discuss the next steps in the contracting process, which will include discussion of the proposed work plan and budget.

Please be advised that this notice starts the five-day period post award inquiry period. Applicants that were not selected to receive funding may file a "Post Award Inquiry" in accordance with the guidance provided in the RFA, Next Steps (page 22). Post award inquiry requests may be sent via email to SMHP@foundationccc.org. **The post award inquiry period will conclude on Tuesday, June 26, 2012 at 5:00 p.m. PST.**

Additionally, I would like to inform you that the CCC SMHP is currently in discussions with the California Mental Health Services Authority (CalMHSA) for additional funding that might be dedicated toward additional Campus Based Grant awards. In the event additional funding


becomes available, the following colleges or consortia will be considered for awards based on their scores in the review process:
