The new big data analytics models rely on real-time data being provided just-in-time to students to ensure that students are receiving personalized support and guidance along their educational pathways. The Chancellor's Office is creating a team to perform historical and real-time analytics on the newly designed big data repository. Under the direction of the Chancellor's Office and in constant and successful collaboration with the Data Services RFA grantee and the Personalization Services RFA, the data analytics team will provide all research, support, and implementation services for existing and future data analytics, reporting, data presentation through dashboards, guidance, legislative data research requests, and other data reporting and analytics needs of the Chancellor's Office.
