RE: Estimated Allocation of the 2018-19 P1 Education Revenue Augmentation Fund  
for the Community College Districts

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The attached table provides the estimated allocations of the Education Revenue Augmentation Fund (ERAF) for community college districts, pursuant to Revenue and Taxation Code Section 97.3 (d) (3).

The ERAF funds were allocated to community college districts in inverse proportion to the amount of local property tax revenue per funded full-time equivalent student (FTES) of the district. The district with the lowest property tax revenue per FTES received the first allocation of revenue from the county's fund until that district achieved the revenue per FTES of the next lowest district within the county. This procedure continued until all revenue was distributed from the fund. No funds have been distributed to a district that is an excess tax school entity. In the event a county determines there is excess ERAF above the allocation schedule provided, the county auditor shall distribute the excess in the same proportion as identified in this allocation schedule.

In the event a county determines there is excess ERAF when the attached schedule indicates zero for any or all districts in the county, please contact us for the appropriate allocation distribution.
