State Budget Update: by Erik Skinner

Executive Vice Chancellor Erik Skinner spoke to Consultation about the state budget. He discussed the following items:

1. LAO's identification of a \$25.4 billion dollar shortfall over the next couple of years.
2. Special Session scheduled for Dec. 6, 2010
3. Possible cuts.
